## **Athlete Guidelines**

- All athletes and coaches in attendance need to have a <u>Right of Entry Waiver signed prior to competing</u>. These will need to be handed to the North Platte head coach in charge of the camp upon arrival.
- Temperatures *MAY* be taken and COVID-19 screening questions *MAY* be asked upon arrival.
- No locker rooms will be made available for athletes to change in. Athletes will be asked to keep all equipment/bags with them at all times.
- No water will be provided to athletes. All athletes are expected to bring their own water.
- When applicable, any food/lunch distributed to athletes will be in the "Grab & Go" format.
- Coaches will work to keep athletes who are not competing in the competition spread out on the sidelines/bleachers.
- No shaking hands or high fives will take place during the camp.
- Equipment and practice areas will be disinfected at the conclusion of each competition.

## **Spectator Guidelines**

- We are treating these camps as PRACTICES as it relates to the Statewide Sports Reopening Guidelines put out by the state of Nebraska.
- With that being said, parents should remain in their cars or drop off and pick players up afterwards.
